RULES AND CONDITIONS:

PLEASE ALSO REFER TO GENERAL CONDITIONS

1. Pianoforte Set Pieces are available at Mackay Music - Sydney Street, Mackay and Yamaha Music - Cnr Victoria & Chain Streets, Mackay.
Please Note: Set pieces must not be performed in any other section of the current Eisteddfod.
2. In Own Choice items, marks will be allotted by the Adjudicator for suitability and standard of work selected.
3. Competitors in Pianoforte sections involving own choice music shall not perform an item or piece which they performed during the previous Eisteddfod.
4. Pitch of the piano will be A440.
5. Competitors must compete in their own age group section to be eligible to enter a higher or open age group.
6. No member of a duet will be permitted to compete in another duet in the same section. In duet sections all details of both competitors must appear on entry form e.g., dates of birth, name, address etc.
7. Duet partners may be from different age groups; however, the competitors must compete in the age group of the elder competitor. (e.g., A duet combination of a 12 Years and Under competitor and a 14 Years and Under competitor must compete in the 14 Years and Under section.)

All Own Choice Material must be submitted at the Mackay Eisteddfod Office, 39 Gordon Street, Mackay on the Own Choice Day:

- Saturday August 5th 9am – 5pm

Competitors unable to submit Own Choice Material on these dates may forward their pieces by Registered Mail only to the Secretary, PO Box 350, Mackay QLD 4740 to arrive with mailing date no later than closing of Own Choice date as above. NO LATE OWN CHOICE SUBMISSIONS WILL BE ACCEPTED

During the Eisteddfod, the Chairperson, Penciller and Adjudicator will not accept any late material under any circumstances. No submitted material may be exchanged for a different piece or swapped between sections after 5pm on Saturday 5th August. Minor changes, e.g. shortening a music piece, will still be allowed.

Own Choice material not received by 5pm on Saturday 5th August will result in the competitor being disqualified. The competitor may still perform and obtain an adjudication but will not receive a mark or a placing.

In each art form the local competitor(s) (15 to 25 Years) who, in the opinion of the Adjudicator present(s) the most outstanding performance, will receive **\$200.00**. To be chosen from Solo, Duo, Trio and Quartet sections only.

To be awarded to the local competitor competing in and securing the most points in any three Open Pianoforte Solo Sections - Bach Prelude and Fugue Open compulsory.

This is a perpetual trophy, to be competed for annually, and a replica will be presented as a memento.

MISS PANSY WOOD MEMORIAL TROPHY

To be awarded to the local competitor competing in and securing the most points in all of the following sections - Grand Pianoforte Championship Solo, Solo by an Australian Composer Open, Bach Prelude and Fugue Open and Sonata Movement Solo Open.

This is a perpetual trophy to be competed for annually and a replica will be presented as a memento.

KERRY HAROLD SCHOOL OF MUSIC TROPHY

To be awarded by the Adjudicator to the local competitor (8 Years and Under) most deserving of encouragement.

RHONDA BATES MUSIC TROPHY

To be awarded by the Adjudicator to the local competitor (9 to 12 Years) most deserving of encouragement.

JAN SHUTTLEWOOD-LAWRENCE TROPHY

To be awarded by the Adjudicator to the local competitor (13 Years and Over) most deserving of encouragement.

DENISE STEVENS MEMORIAL TROPHY

To be awarded to the local competitor competing in and securing the most points in all of the following sections - Bach Solo, Set Solo and Grand Pianoforte Solo. Competitors must be 12 Years as at the 1st January 2023 and must compete in the 12 Years and Under sections.

ANNE THOMPSON MEMORIAL TROPHY

To be awarded to the local competitor competing in and securing the most points in all of the following sections - Bach Solo, Set Solo and Grand Pianoforte Solo. Competitors must be 13 to 14 Years as at the 1st January 2023 and must compete in the 14 Years and Under sections.

This is a perpetual trophy to be competed for annually with prize money of **\$50.00**

TRINITY COLLEGE LONDON TROPHY

To be awarded to the local competitor competing in and securing the most points in all of the following sections: - Bach Solo, Set Solo and Grand Pianoforte Solo. Competitors must be 15 to 16 Years as at the 1st January 2023 and must compete in the 16 Years and Under sections.

JOYCE CALDWELL MEMORIAL AWARD
