ADMISSION CHARGES FOR 2026 EISTEDDFOD

MEGA-PASS

- \$120 (Adults/Children/Concession)
- A Mega-Pass provides unlimited access to all venues for the duration of the Eisteddfod for ALL dates (August and October events)
- Available from Mackay Eisteddfod Office (Parish Hall, 39a Gordon Street, Mackay). Open Tuesdays and Thursdays.
- On application, please supply a passport-size photo.
- THE MEGA-PASS IS NOT TRANSFERABLE.
- Your Mega Pass must be presented to the Box Office to book tickets for sessions with allocated seating. For general admission sessions the pass can be presented directly to the door person.

TICKETS

- \$10 - All Group Sessions (Adult/Child/Pensioner)
- \$ 7 - All Other Sessions (Adult/Child/Pensioner)

Tickets will be available via the MECC, both online and at the Box Office. Cash or Card accepted.

IMPORTANT NOTICES

- During the running of the event, the Eisteddfod Association office will be located on level 1 of the MECC (go up the stairs near door 1).
- In fairness and respect to competitors, audience members should remain seated and observe complete silence during performances. The doors will be closed, and no person will be allowed to enter or leave the auditorium while a competitor is performing.
- The use of mobile recording devices, videos and cameras by the audience is strictly prohibited. Capturing images of performers under 18 may constitute an offence. We have official photographers and videographers at the event.
- Local Competitors are those living within the boundaries of Proserpine, St. Lawrence and Dysart.
- Competitors are reminded of the generosity of donors of trophies, medals and special prize monies. Thank you notes for donors are encouraged and can be left at the Eisteddfod Office for distribution.
- A high standard of decorum is expected from all participants and spectators. Any unsportsmanlike behaviour will be dealt with accordingly.
- Competitors compete at their own risk.

INFORMATION FOR ALL PERFORMERS

General Performance Information

1. Please arrive early, 15 to 30 minutes before the scheduled start of your session.
2. All competitors must register before the beginning of the section with a designated official. He / she will mark your number off on the running sheet. Be prepared to answer any questions about your performance.
3. **A competitor who fails to register prior to the start of a section (unless having notified the office & gained permission for late arrival), will not be eligible to compete in that section.**
4. Wait quietly for your number to be called before stepping on to the stage.
5. No prompting from the audience or side stage will be permitted. Competitors who are prompted will face disqualification.
6. An Adjudication critique will be provided (except in Highland and Irish Dancing sections). Depending on art form, these will be available as an audio critique (via Music Uploads) OR as a hard copy (from the Eisteddfod Office).

PLEASE NOTE: No competitor will be allowed to have a mobile phone or other mobile device side stage. This applies to competitors across all art forms.

OWN CHOICE SUBMISSION

- **Choral and Vocal:** All Choral and Vocal competitors will be emailed individually (early in July) with the requirements on how to upload their sheet music. Music Upload cutoff date 4th August 2026 (midnight).
- **Pianoforte and Instrumental Sections (500 to 505 and 551 to 567):** – A copy of Own Choice pieces must be submitted together with full particulars of item attached during Own Choice Day: Saturday 1st August, 9:00am - 4:00pm. Venue: Mackay Eisteddfod Office (Parish Hall, 39a Gordon St, Mackay).
- **Instrumental Groups:** – Sections 506 through to 521 – Scores for Adjudicators may be submitted to the Eisteddfod Office on Own Choice Day (Saturday 1st August, 9:00am - 4:00pm) or at the Venue on the day of performance, at least 30 minutes prior to the start of the Session. Scores must be in performance order in a clearly marked folder with the School name and Section entered.

Any own choice material not received by the nominated cut-off date may result in the competitor being disqualified. **NO late own choice submissions will be accepted.** The onus is on the competitor to ensure the submitted material is correct as exchanges will not be permitted.

CLASHES

Entrants must appear in their section in program order, or forfeit their right to perform, except when clashes between art forms occur and prior arrangement has been made with a committee member at the Eisteddfod Office. Competitors will not be allowed to change to another sub-section where sections have been split into A and B, etc.

We do try to prevent clashes between items of different art forms; however, it is possible given the thousands of performances that two of your items may clash.

Should this occur:

1. See a committee member in the Eisteddfod Office at least one day before the scheduled performances.
2. The committee member will arrange with the Artform head if it is possible, for you to perform out of turn so that you may compete in both sections.
3. Changes to the program can only occur through this process. Under no circumstances should a competitor, or representative, request special consideration from anyone other than a committee member working in the Eisteddfod Office.

WITHDRAWALS

Competitors who do not intend to compete in a section for which they have entered should notify the Eisteddfod Office before the time appointed for that section.

GENERAL RULES AND CONDITIONS - EXCERPT

The following is an excerpt from the Rules and Conditions. A full list is printed in the Preliminary Schedule. Competitors are asked to read these Rules and Conditions carefully.

- This competition is open to amateurs only. The term 'amateur' is defined as one whose principal source of income is not derived from performing that talent required for any sections entered. This condition does not apply to conductors or accompanists.
- No teacher or parent will be allowed on stage unless as an accompanist or conductor.
- Communication with Adjudicators is strictly prohibited. If it is established that any competitor or unauthorised person has been in contact with an Adjudicator during the course of the Eisteddfod, the Committee reserves the right to disqualify that competitor.
- Competitors must not have had any tuition from any of the Adjudicators for a period of six months prior to the commencement of the Eisteddfod.
- Competitors may face disqualification if they do not adhere to time limits set out for various sections. In sections where a time limit is specified, the ringing of a bell will indicate that the time limit has been exceeded, and the competitor must cease to perform.

- The same item (or part thereof) must not be performed more than once by the same competitor throughout the duration of the Eisteddfod (excluding Highland and Irish Dancing).
- The Committee reserves the right to refuse an Eisteddfod entry and to alter the order of a program without prior notice.
- No protest concerning the eligibility of a competitor to compete will be permitted unless made in writing to the Eisteddfod Office on paper or via email (office@mackayeisteddfod.org) prior to the commencement of the Eisteddfod, accompanied by a fee of \$20.00. No other protest or disputed matter will be permitted unless made in writing to the Eisteddfod Office on paper or via email (office@mackayeisteddfod.org) within half an hour of the case arising, accompanied by a fee of \$20.00. In all cases the fee will be forfeited if the protest or dispute is deemed frivolous.
- First, Second, Third and Highly Commended placings will be awarded in all sections (excluding Choral and Vocal Primary Group Sections where Gold, Silver and Bronze awards are given). The Adjudicator has the right to withhold any prize where he/she considers there is not sufficient merit.
- The Eisteddfod Committee will NOT be liable for any copyright infringement relating to the submission of digital and paper copies. Entrants submit copies and works at their own risk. All photocopies submitted for the Adjudicator's use will be destroyed after the completion of the section. One Music forms must be submitted with music copies.
- The use of mobile recording devices, videos and cameras by the audience is prohibited as the capturing of images of performers under 18 may constitute an offence. The Eisteddfod Committee reserves the right to Photograph, record, film, broadcast, videotape or post on our website or Facebook page any item or section of the Eisteddfod. Competitors and/or winner's names and/or photographs may be published by the official photographer or the Eisteddfod committee. Should this not be appropriate the Eisteddfod office MUST BE notified in writing prior to the commencement of the Eisteddfod.
- **Every competitor has the right to feel safe at our event. It is strictly prohibited to repost or distribute any official or unofficial recording, photograph or message to a social platform or multiple recipients with the intent to menace/harass/intimidate/ ridicule/humiliate a competitor.** This will result in immediate disqualification from the current competition with consideration by the executive of exclusion from future events. All such matters, in consultation with the targeted person (victim), may be reported to police.
- Only competitors and designated teachers or studio/school representatives will be permitted backstage.
- **No competitor will be allowed to have a mobile phone or other mobile device side stage. This applies to competitors across all art forms.**
- No competitor may use the stage without permission from the Stage Manager.
- A high standard of decorum is expected from all participants and spectators. Unseemly behavior will result in offenders being asked to leave and offending competitors being disqualified. In the event of property being damaged in any way, the offenders will be charged accordingly.

The decision of the Committee shall be final and binding in all matters relating to the interpretation of the Rules and Conditions of the Eisteddfod.
